A total of 7,000 risk and need COMPAS Assessments have been completed.</p> <p>Chief Myer presented and reviewed data from 2013, 2014, and 2015 regarding Electronic Monitoring, Jail Releases, TAD, and Adult Placements.</p> <p>Chief Myer presented and reviewed data from February 2013 to June 2015. The collaboration of the Police Probation Partnership has conducted 3071 contacts, seized 100 weapons, served 447 warrants, seized an excess of 202 pounds of drugs, and executed 1244 arrests.</p> <p>Since Proposition 47, there has been a 15% decrease in auto thefts.
