ш.	New Business	 (a) Probation Updates: Chief Vernon mentioned that positions are being filled, and staffing has increased. This has decreased the number of shifts Deputy Probation Officers have to work at the Juvenile Detention Facility. Officers can now focus more on being out in the field. (b) The growth funding for Fiscal Year 2022-23 that was voted on and approved at the last CCP meeting was approved by the Board of Supervisors in June. (c) Chief Vernon said AB 2282, which would have changed the makeup of the CCP committee, died in appropriations. AB 1057, which would have removed JJCPA and YOBG funding, also died in appropriations. It can be expected to see forms of both bills next year. CPOC will continue to fight them at the state level. 	Chief Vernon
