Local Innovation Funds	Chief Probation Officer Kelly Vernon reminded everyone that there is an item called the Local Innovation Funds, which requires the committee to allocate 10 percent of the Realignment Growth and put it in a Local Innovation Fund, and is available for local spending at the discretion of the Board of Supervisors. Any spending from this fund will require Board approval. There was a memorandum that was sent out in February 2014 describing what the fund entails. 	In fiscal year 2024-25, the office received \$446,595, which was allocated to salary, benefits, and other associated costs, such as workers' compensation, retirement, social security, etc. Those associated with these positions do not solely work on AB 109 cases. The current case management system is limited, and it would be extremely difficult to divide work among these employees. Mary Escarsega-Fechner, Executive Director of C-SET, Inc., stated that there may be opportunities for intervention that non-profit organizations can help with and collaborate on. C-SET is interested in partnering with the Public Defender to be part of this effort. Tim Hire, Superintendent of the Tulare County Office of Education (TCOE), added that TCOE may also have opportunities to expand collaboration efforts that they are already conducting with HHSA and may be able to help with this endeavor. 	The action was unanimously approved.	
b. Public Defender's funding request	The department finalized contract negotiations for a new cloud-based case management system designed by and for public defenders. A Board Agenda Item is being prepared for the Board of Supervisors. The current system, in use since 2007, is outdated and no longer meets operational needs. After reviewing six systems, the selected platform stood out for its robust features, including workflow customization, enhanced data capture, client-centered design, and built-in client communication tools (e.g., text messaging with automatic logging). It integrates discovery, case files, and client records in one place, supports advanced AI search, and simplifies information sharing with justice partners. The total start-up cost is \$132,800, with \$115,000 already secured. A request for \$17,800 in additional funds will cover the shortfall. Key cost areas include data conversion, database and file migration, integration with court systems, and AWS transfer setup. The vendor is contributing 500 donated hours (valued at \$80,000).
